



Who is Carbon Neutral?

- Carbon Neutral is a not for profit organisation started by Men of the Trees in WA.
- Since 2001, Carbon Neutral has established approximately two million trees and shrubs in WA, SA & Victoria.
- Carbon Neutral collects donations from individuals and organisations nationally that choose to help the environment by establishing trees and shrubs.
- Men of the Trees are contracted to work directly with land owners to arrange preparation, planting and maintenance.

How does it work?

- A site manager will inspect your property to assess suitability and discuss an appropriate planting design.
- You will need to sign a legal deed confirming your agreement to the terms, and a caveat will be placed over your land title.
- A Land Owner Agreement outlining your responsibilities and proposed income schedule will be sent.
- Once confirmed, seedlings will be planted on your property.
- A confirmation of income schedule will be sent to you once the planting is complete.
- A survey is undertaken of the planting.
- A Land Owner Agreement incorporating the survey document will be sent to you for signing.
- When you sign the Carbon Right and Covenant the Caveat will be lifted from your property.
- Once the deed is registered seedlings can be planted on your property.

Important Points

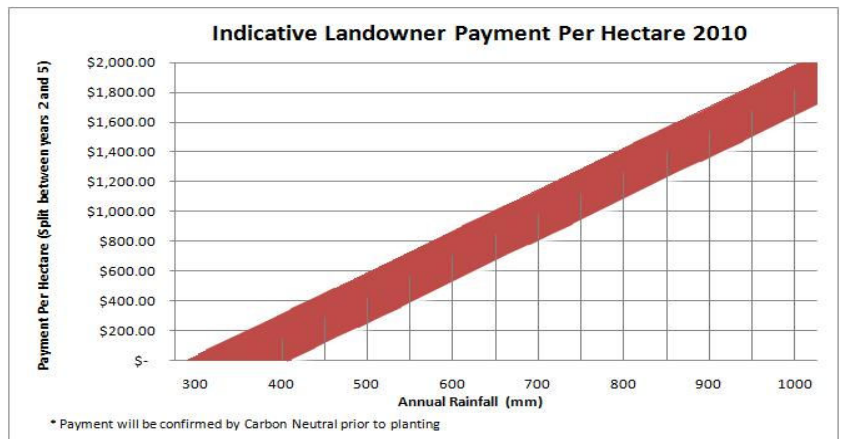
- The seedlings will be planted with the intention that the trees and shrubs remain on the land indefinitely.
- You must not intentionally damage the trees or shrubs.
- Stock must be kept away from the trees and shrubs during the first few years.
- There will be at least four legal documents to sign. A 100 year carbon right and carbon covenant is placed on the land title to protect the trees and shrubs (even if the land is sold).

Benefits

- All costs of planting and seedlings are covered by Carbon Neutral.
- The preparation and planting of the seedlings is undertaken by contractors or volunteers or
- You could be paid to prepare the land and plant the seedlings on your own property as per the following schedule:
 - Site preparation - \$150 per ha
 - Spraying - \$50 per ha for each spray
 - Planting - 25c per seedling.
- You have a choice of biodiversity or oil mallee seedlings.
- Potential productivity improvement
- An incentive payment based on projected sequestration rates will be paid, half at year 2 and half at year 5



Why Establish Native Trees and Shrubs?

Benefits vary from site to site and include:

- absorb carbon dioxide as they grow
- rehabilitate degraded land
- can be used to combat salinity
- increase natural biodiversity
- stabilises soil from wind and water erosion
- may increase regional rainfall
- can shelter livestock once established
